RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Acceptance of Special Contract Under  
Conditions Deviating from Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 928-G, filed July 11, 1977, having requested authorization to carry out the terms and conditions of a special contract with The City of Santa Clara (Applicant) covering a gas main extension to provide natural gas service to Applicant's commercial and industrial development entitled Oakmead-Unit III in Santa Clara County, under conditions deviating from filed tariffs, and resulting in the following:

1. The agreement deviates from filed tariffs in that the Applicant will pay in advance of construction, \$56,096 representing the estimated total cost of facilities less a credit of \$6,564 for trenching and backfilling to be done by Applicant.
2. The agreement further deviates from filed tariffs in that the Applicant is required to pay a cost-of-ownership fund of \$27,599.23, which is the present worth of annual charges of 12% per annum for five years.
3. Prior approvals to provide similar facilities to earlier portions of this development were granted to this Applicant by Commission Resolutions Nos. G-1726 and G-1855, dated March 11, 1975 and March 2, 1976, respectively.
4. We find that this agreement is compensatory and nondiscriminatory and provides for service to the Applicant in such a manner as to not place a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Section XB of General Order No. 96-A and under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to place this contract into effect on August 10, 1977.
2. The above advice letter and contract be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2128. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
