SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Reduction on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 395-G, filed August 15, 1977, requests authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and Section III-F of General Order No. 96-A to place into effect a reduction in the commodity rate of Schedule G-54, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2561-G and 2562-G on less than statutory notice.

1. The proposed revision will provide a rate reduction from 265.00 cents per million Btu to 250.00 cents per million Btu for rate Schedule G-54.
2. This change will reduce the rate for interdepartmental gas service so that this rate will not exceed the cost of residual oil burned by San Diego in its electric generating plant.
3. The utility requests that this filing be made on less than statutory notice; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and Section III-F of General Order 96-A to make the above sheets effective as of August 16, 1977.
2. The above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2132. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
