R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Tracking Rate Increase  
on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 109-G, filed September 14, 1977, having requested authority under the provisions of Decision No. 84765, and under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code, to file revised tariff sheets applicable to its Needles rate area, in order to track a rate increase filed by Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) Advice Letter No. 938-G, and as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 540-G to 542-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The proposed rate increase of 0.074 cents per therm for all nonlifeline rates will result in an annual revenue increase of \$518, which will offset the proposed PG&E rate increase.

2. For a typical residential customer under lifeline rate schedules, using 40 therms in the summer months and 150 therms in the winter months, the bill will increase \$0.01 from \$14.20 to \$14.21 in the summer and by \$0.05 from \$49.30 to \$49.35 in the winter.

3. For a commercial customer under nonlifeline rate schedules, using the same volumes, the bill will increase \$0.03 from \$17.20 to \$17.23 in the summer and by \$0.11 from \$58.54 to \$58.65 in the winter.

4. An effective date of October 1, 1977 is requested to coincide with the proposed effective date of PG&E's Advice Letter No. 938-G, and in the event that the Commission should require PG&E to file different rates or use a different effective date than anticipated, Cal-Pac will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels.

5. This requested increase is found to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code, and under the provisions of Decision No. 84765, to place the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on October 1, 1977, or on any subsequent date that the Commission should require PG&E Advice Letter No. 938-G to be effective.

2. The above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2149. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof. I hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was duly introduced, passed and adopted at a regular conference of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, held on the 27th day of September, 1977, the following Commissioners voting favorably thereon:
