SUBJECT: Request to Provide Temporary Natural Gas Service
Under Priority 2A

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1094, filed September 20, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas service to Keysor-Century Corporation (Applicant) in Saugus, Los Angeles County, under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional 107 Mcf on a peak day to operate (on a temporary basis) a gas fired fume incinerator in the manufacture of PVC resin and phonograph records.
2. Applicant's existing load is 463 Mcf on a peak day in Priority 3.
3. The Environmental Protection Agency has ordered Applicant to incinerate plant fumes by October 1, 1977.
4. An oil fired fume incinerator is not available in time to avoid plant shut-down.
5. Applicant will install an oil fired fume incinerator by October 1, 1978.
6. We find that this request should be granted and that Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A (temporary) under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189 until October 1, 1978, at which time this service will be terminated; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 and under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to Keysor-Century Corporation and to classify applicant's fume incinerator as Priority 2A (temporary), until October 1, 1978, effective October 4, 1977.
2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2151. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
