SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 939-G, filed September 15, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to K. S. Maughan (Applicant) in Selma, Fresno County under the following circumstances:

- 1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 2,650 Mcf.
- 2. Applicant will use this gas to operate 24 direct fired dehydrators to process raisins and prunes.
- 3. Fuel oil cannot be used to dry the fruit since products of combustion could contaminate or damage the product.
- 4. Use of solar energy to dry fruit has not been demonstrated and proved on a commercial basis.
- 5. Applicant meets the criteria for FPC Priority 2 classification (Docket No. RP 72-6).
- 6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested service to K. S. Maughan, effective October 15, 1977.
- 2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2153. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
