> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision of Tariff Schedules to Create New Rate Schedule Ultimately Resulting in More Restrictive Rates

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1102, filed October 31, 1977, having requested authority to file revised tariff schedules, to file a rate schedule applicable to swimming pool heating, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 15055-G to 15057-G, inclusive under the following conditions:

1. The new rate schedule is a result of Decision No. 87192, dated April 12, 1977, and Decision No. 87515, dated June 28, 1977 in Case No. 9642, et. al.

2. Schedule No. GPH, Nonresidential Pool Heater Service, was established for all new municipal, school or commercial swimming pool heating, classified as Priorities P-1 or P-2 and currently has the same rate schedule as in existing Schedule GNR.

3. Upon Commission authorization of revised rates in pending PGA Application No. 57573, SoCal will file revised rates for Schedule SPH to reflect the customer charge and the higher commodity rate prescribed for nonresidential Priority P-1 service.

4. The number of customers to be served under this schedule is unknown at this time.

5. We find that this new rate schedule is in keeping with the will and intent of Decisions Nos. 87192 and 87515, and no burden will be placed on other ratepayers by adoption of this rate schedule at present GNR rates pending a decision in Application No. 57573; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 453, 455 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code and under Section II B. (1) of General Order No. 96-A for Southern California Gas Company to place the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on December 1, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2166. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
