SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision of Tariff Schedules to Create New Rate Schedules Involving Increased Rates

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1103, filed October 31, 1977, having requested authority to file revised tariff schedules to include a rate schedule applicable to Priority 2A (temporary) customers, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 15058-G to 15065-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The new rate schedule is a result of Decision No. 87784, dated August 30, 1977, in Case No. 9642, et. al.

2. Schedule No. GT-2, Commercial and Industrial Natural Gas Service, will remain in effect until October 1, 1978 and provides that customers with adequate standby facilities and fuel may request transfer to the appropriate lower priority rate schedule at any time prior to that date.

3. Customers transferred to Schedule No. GT-2 will receive a commodity rate increase from 19.844¢ per therm to 25.540¢ per therm plus a monthly customer charge of \$15.00 in keeping with the provisions of Decision No. 87784 that the rates should not be less than the equivalent cost of the unit fuel costs that such Priority 2A customer would have been exposed to if such customer had been transferred to the appropriate lower priority and curtailed accordingly.

4. We find these rate revisions to be reasonable and allows for equitable rates for all customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to place the above tariff sheets into effect on December 2, 1977, which constitutes more than regular statutory notice.

2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2167. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
