RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision to Existing Tariff Rule Created by Prior Commission Order

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1105, filed November 7, 1977, having requested authority to file revised tariffs to modify Rule No. 14.1 to have space conditioning systems operate in a manner which minimizes total energy use, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 15070-G to 15072-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. Rule No. 23.1, Interim Emergency Order-Prohibitions, Conservation and Curtailment Provisions was initially established in accordance with the provisions of Decision No. 86932, dated February 1, 1977 and subsequently revised by Commission Decision No. 87017, dated February 28, 1977.
2. Rule No. 23.1 is herewith further revised pursuant to Commission staff's request by letter dated October 13, 1977.
3. The revision involves the addition of a paragraph stating that any commercial industrial building wherein the space heating and cooling control systems provide for a single temperature setpoint, or where the heating and cooling system operate simultaneously, the space conditioning systems shall be operated in a manner which minimizes total energy use.
4. We find that this revision will be in keeping with the will and intent of Decisions Nos. 86932 and 87017 in promoting conservation of energy; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 490 and 1708 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to place the above tariff sheets into effect on December 7, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2170. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
