SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfc

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 953-G, filed November 15, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Cal-Compack Foods, Inc (Applicant) in King City, Monterey County under the following circumstances:

- 1. Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption during the months of October to December of 1,680 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 849 Mcf to 2,529 Mcf.
- 2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate a direct-fired food dehydrator.
- 3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without product contamination since the products of combustion come in direct contact with the food being dehydrated.
- 4. Food dehydration using solar energy has not yet been demonstrated on a commercial scale.
- 5. Applicant meets the criteria for FPC Priority 2 classification (Docket No. RP 72-6).
- 6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85139; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Cal-Compack Foods, Inc. effective this date.
- 2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2178. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
