SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less  
 Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in Increased Charges


WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1111, filed December 1, 1977, having requested Commission authority under Section 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-60, Wholesale Natural Gas Service and to file the Fourteenth Supplemental Service Agreement between the utility and the City of Long Beach as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 15097-G to 15102-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The revisions would provide for increases in the City's daily contract demand from 74,000 Mcf to 77,000 Mcf and extends for another year the additional peaking demand of 25,000 Mcf.
2. The City requests these increased quantities in order to meet anticipated requirements on its system.
3. By Resolution No. C-22418, dated November 29, 1977, the City of Long Beach authorized the City Manager to execute this Fifteenth Service Agreement with Southern California Gas Company.
4. The utility and the City are currently in negotiations for a new service agreement which, if approved by the Commission, will supersede and replace the existing agreement.
5. The requested effective date of December 1, 1977 coincides with the anniversary date of the Long Beach Service Agreement.
6. It is found that this rate revision is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective retroactively as of December 1, 1977.
2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2181. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
