SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service in
Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 957-G, filed December 21, 1977 has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Gilroy Foods, Inc. (Applicant) in Patterson, Stanislaus County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional peak daily consumption of 20 Mcf, raising his existing peak daily consumption from 61 Mcf to 81 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas in two direct fired tunnel vegetable dryers.
3. Fuel Oil cannot be used in this direct fired process without product contamination.
4. Solar energy has not yet been commercially demonstrated.
5. Applicant meets the criteria for FPC Priority 2 classification (Docket No. RP72-6).
6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 1 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested service to Gilroy Foods, Inc. effective January 20, 1978.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were approved for filing by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2185. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
