SUBJECT: Order Suspending Reporting Requirements.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letters dated December 29, 1977 and February 2, 1978, having requested that the 1977 and subsequent reports associated with meter density be suspended as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's suggestion in Decision No. 47990, dated December 2, 1952, the utility has filed by May 1st of each year a meter density report, based upon the previous year end statistics.
2. By Commission Decision No. 87587, dated July 12, 1977, in Application No. 57196, the Commission eliminated rate zones for the general service customers, but this decision is presently on appeal to the California State Supreme Court.
3. In the event that Decision No. 87587 is upheld, the filing of annual meter density reports will become unnecessary, however, pending the court appeal, the utility requests permission to suspend submission of the report.
4. It is found that this request is reasonable and that such meter density report will not be required; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southern California Gas Company need not file the annual meter density reports unless ordered to do so by future order of this Commission. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
