SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Temporary Natural Gas Service
 in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 996-G, filed May 18, 1978 has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional temporary natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to the Airports Commission (Applicant) at San Francisco International Airport, San Mateo County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for temporary additional natural gas service for a heating plant during a massive reconstruction and expansion project which will require simultaneous operation of the old and new heating plants. Upon completion of the project on or about December 31, 1981 the old heating plant will be eliminated.
2. Applicant's request is for an additional peak day consumption of 361 Mcf, raising the peak day consumption from 632 Mcf to 993 Mcf.
3. The Commission staff has prepared recommendations to modify Decision No. 85189 in light of current gas supply conditions which will in effect rescind Ordering Paragraph 3 on use of alternate fuel in place of gas to commercial customers.
4. The staff recommends approval.

WHEREAS: We find that Applicant is a commercial customer, that this request should be approved in advance of the pending modifications to Decision No. 85189, and that Applicant should be classified as Priority 4 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, Pacific Gas & Electric Company is authorized to supply the requested temporary service to the Airports Commission until December 31, 1981 effective this date.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were accepted for filing by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2230. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
