SUBJECT: Request for Additional Time Extension for Priority 3 Classification

WHEREAS: THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA by letter dated July 20, 1978, have requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 86357 to extend the Priority 3 classification of the University of California, San Francisco Medical Center (UCSF) in the City and County of San Francisco, for an additional 12 months under the following circumstances:

1. Decision No. 86357 changed UCSF's boiler fuel gas usage from Priority 3 to Priority 4.

2. At the request of the Regents of the University of California in Application No. 56959, and by Decision No. 87136, the Commission authorized a continuation of Priority 3 boiler fuel gas service to UCSF until December 31, 1978, the estimated installation date for additional alternate fuel storage capacity.

3. The UCSF proceeded in good faith and with due diligence to accomplish the additional fuel tank construction, but due to the complexities and the time requirements of the various prerequisite steps, UCSF's estimates of completion dates have proven inadequate.

4. Present estimates indicate the additional fuel tank installation will be completed within possibly nine more months.

5. The staff recommends approval of the requested twelve month extension until December 31, 1979.

WHEREAS: We find that this request for deviation from the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 86357 should be granted, and that the University of California, San Francisco Medical Center should be classified as Priority 3 until December 31, 1979; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to deviate from the provisions of Decision No. 86357, and to provide the requested service as Priority 3 to the University of California, San Francisco Medical Center until December 31, 1979, effective this date.

2. The above letter be marked to show that it was accepted for filing by Resolution G-2239 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
