SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1156, filed October 30, 1978, requests authority under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-60, Wholesale Natural Gas Service, and to file the Sixteenth Supplemental Service Agreement between the utility and the City of Long Beach as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 15293-G to 15298-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The revisions to the service agreement include increasing the daily contract demand from 77,000 to 79,000 Mcf per day, and extending for another year the additional peaking demand at the existing levels of 25,000 Mcf per day and 500,000 Mcf for the winter period, December 1 through March 15.
2. The estimated annual effect of this revision is an increase in revenue to the utility from the City of Long Beach of \$16,000.
3. Long Beach has requested these increased quantities in order to meet anticipated requirements on its system.
4. By Resolution No. C-22611, dated October 10, 1978, the City of Long Beach authorized the City Manager to execute this Sixteenth Service Agreement with Southern California Gas Company.
5. The requested effective date of December 1, 1978 coincides with the anniversary date of the Long Beach Service Agreement, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on December 1, 1978.
2. The above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution No. G-2254 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
