SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deferral of Effective Date of Previously
 Approved Steam Rate Schedules.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E) by Advice Letter No. 61-S, filed February 2, 1979, requested authority to adjust its steam rate schedules, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 237-H and 238-H, with the following results:

1. The Commission, on February 27, 1979, by Resolution No. G-2262, approved a Steam Rate increase of \$0.658 per 1,000 lbs. of steam, resulting in an annual revenue increase of \$334,500 or 8.4% for PG&E's Steam Department.
2. The effective date of this filing was March 5, 1979, which constituted regular statutory notice.
3. The Hotel Employer's Association of San Francisco (Hotel Assn.) was scheduled to receive a copy of this Advice Letter filing but due to inadvertent action of the utility this notice was not received on a timely basis.
4. By letter dated March 1, 1979, the legal representatives of Hotel Assn. protested the fact that they had just received a copy of the filing and had insufficient time for review.
5. By letter dated March 2, 1979, PG&E requests that the effective date of Advice Letter No. 61-S and of the above tariff sheets be deferred from March 5, 1979 to April 1, 1979, in order to allow Hotel Assn. to review the filing and to respond if desired, and

WHEREAS: We find that this request is reasonable and in the best interest of all parties concerned; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under Sections 701 and 1708 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Commission Resolution No. G-2262 to defer the effective date of the above tariff sheets from March 5, 1979 to April 1, 1979.
2. All other provisions of Resolution No. G-2262 remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
