SUBJECT: Authorizing Acceptance of Special Contract Under Conditions Deviating from Filed Tariffs.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 1038-G, filed April 6, 1979, has requested authorization to carry out the terms and conditions of a special contract with RIBCO, Inc., covering a gas main and distribution extension to provide natural gas service to RIBCO's commercial and industrial development under conditions deviating from filed tariffs, and resulting in the following:

1. The agreement deviates from filed tariffs in that RIBCO will pay a refundable advance of \$11,456, representing the total cost of the facilities.
2. The agreement further deviates from filed tariffs by requiring a monthly cost-of-ownership payment of \$114.56 equal to 1% of the advance.
3. In the event that refunds are made on the advance, the cost-of-ownership charge will be adjusted accordingly.
4. RIBCO desires the gas facilities for an industrial park development and is not the ultimate consumer of gas and it is not determined at this time who will be the ultimate consumers.
5. This agreement is similar in context with the agreements filed by Advice Letters Nos. 1027-G to 1034-G, inclusive and authorized by Commission Resolution No. G-2270 on April 10, 1979, and

WHEREAS: We find that this agreement is compensatory and nondiscriminatory and will provide service to the applicant in such a manner as to not place a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to place this contract in effect on May 6, 1979.
2. The above advice letter and contract be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution No. G-2272 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
