SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions to Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 1040-G, filed May 9, 1979, requests authority under Sections 491 and 739 of the Public Utilities Code to file revised tariff schedules, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10391-G to 10396-G, inclusive, to provide a lifeline allowance for gas air conditioning equipment under the following conditions:

1. The Preliminary Statement is revised to provide two levels of air conditioning allowances, following the divisions set up for electric air conditioning established by Decision No. 89316, dated September 6, 1978, in Application No. 57285.
2. The lifeline allowance for gas air conditioning is established in Schedules Nos. G-1, GS and GT as 50 therms.
3. The lifeline allowances for Schedule No. GM are 60% of the allowances for Schedule No. GS based on the differing allowances established for electric air conditioning in Schedules Nos. DM and DS.
4. Based on recorded data it is estimated that PG&E will experience a reduction in revenue of \$67,400 during the 1979 cooling season due to the lifeline allowances for gas air conditioning equipment.

WHEREAS: We find these revisions will not increase any rates or charges, nor conflict with other schedules or rules; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted by Sections 491 and 739 of the Public Utilities Code for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to place the foregoing tariff sheets into effect on June 1, 1979.
 2. The foregoing advice letter and tariff sheets be marked to show that they were approved for filing by Resolution No. G-2279 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
