(GEDA) Project Letter No. 78-I Pursuant to Procedures Prescribed by Decision No. 88121.

WHEREAS: NATURAL GAS CORPORATION OF CALIFORNIA AND PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter of May 15, 1979, have requested that the interim GEDA funding of certain Rocky Mountain exploration and development activities authorized by Resolution No. G-2220 dated May 16, 1978, be extended under the following circumstances:

- 1. Resolution No. G-2220 authorized GEDA funding of Pacific Transmission Supply Company's (PTS) drilling program through 1978 and part of 1979, pending Commission action on Project Letter No. 78-M, which requests GEDA treatment of a comprehensive 10-year drilling program, and which has been set for public hearings beginning June 18, 1979.
- 2. The gross expenditures authorized for the interim program under Resolution No. G-2220 totaled \$15,600,000, which is expected to be depleted by early June 1979.
- 3. The instant request is to extend interim GEDA funding through the third quarter of 1979, pending Commission action on Project Letter No. 78-M.
- 4. The additional gross expenditures required through the third quarter of 1979 are estimated to be \$16,000,000, which translates to a cost-of-service of approximately \$575,000 in 1979 and \$1,500,000 in 1980.
- 5. The terms and conditions will be subject to revision consistent with the terms and conditions ultimately adopted by the Commission with respect to the comprehensive program. Should the Commission not approve the comprehensive program, NGC would retain the acreage earned from PTS under the interim agreement.
- 6. We find that the request to extend the interim GEDA funding under Project Letter No. 78-I should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary. Therefore, good cause appearing,
