SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Extension of Deadline as Determined by Prior Commission Decision.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SoCal), by Advice Letter No. 1177, filed June 4, 1979, has requested Commission approval to deviate from the provisions of Decision No. 88664 in Case No. 9642 under the following conditions:

1. This request is made on behalf of Southwest Foam Molding, Inc. in order to extend for an additional 120 days the deadline for transferring priority of service from Priority 2AT to Priority 3.

2. Under the provisions of Decision No. 88664, the customer is scheduled to make the priority transfer by October 1, 1979 including installing facilities for alternate fuel capability.

3. Southwest Foam Molding, Inc., is a manufacturer of styrofoam products and is located in Downey, but who proposes to move to larger facilities in Fontana by February 1980.

4. The customer would incur unnecessary financial hardships if it were required to install alternate fuel capacity at the old plant in order to meet Priority 3 requirements by October 1, 1979 and then have to move all facilities to the new plant a few months later, and

WHEREAS: We find that this request to delay priority transfer is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under Section 490 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to deviate from the provisions of Decision No. 88664 by allowing Southwest Foam Molding, Inc. to remain as a Priority 2AT for an additional 120 days beyond the October 1, 1979 deadline.

2. The above advice letter is to be marked to show that it was approved for filing by Resolution No. G-2285 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
