SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision of the Excess Footage Costs for Gas Main Extensions.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SoCal), by Advice Letter No. 1178, filed June 11, 1979, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 20, Gas Main Extensions, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 15424-G to 15426-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The revision to Rule 20 would increase the advance supplied by customer per foot of gas main extension beyond the allowable free length from \$3.50 to \$3.90 per foot of gas main extension.
2. The reason for the above revision is the utility review of current construction costs in conformance with Section E.2. of Rule No. 20.
3. No significant change in revenue will be realized by the utility due to this revision because it will merely offset existing construction costs, and

WHEREAS: We find that this revision is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective July 11, 1979, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution No. G-2287 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
