1. Garden Valley Foods' request is for an additional average daily consumption of 553 Mcf, raising his existing daily consumption from 400 Mcf to 953 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas to fuel a boiler used in food processing.
3. In the absence of additional natural gas, Garden Valley Foods would be required to use middle distillates at a time when efforts are being made to reduce demand pressures on the fuel oil market.

WHEREAS: We find this request should be granted and that service to Garden Valley Foods should be classified as Priority 4 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 86357; therefore, good cause appearing,
