SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas for Industrial Boiler Fuel in Excess of 300 Mcf/d

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1047-G, filed July 12, 1979, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 89337, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 300 Mcf/d to Garden Valley Foods in Gilroy, Santa Clara County under the following circumstances:

1. Garden Valley Foods' request is for an additional average daily consumption of 553 Mcf, raising his existing daily consumption from 400 Mcf to 953 Mcf.

2. Applicant will use this additional gas to fuel a boiler used in food processing.

3. In the absence of additional natural gas, Garden Valley Foods would be required to use middle distilates at a time when efforts are being made to reduce demand pressures on the fuel oil market.

WHEREAS: We find this request should be granted and that service to Garden Valley Foods should be classified as Priority 4 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 86357; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 89337 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested service to Garden Valley Foods.

2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2293. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
