SUBJECT: Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation Request for Service Under Pacific Gas and Electric Company Schedule G-55A - Cogeneration Natural Gas Service

WHEREAS: Morrison & Foerster, Attorneys for Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation (KMCC), by letter dated January 23, 1980, have requested authorization for KMCC to receive service under PG&E's Schedule G-55A Cogeneration Natural Gas Service, under the following circumstances:

1. Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation ("KMCC"), by letter dated January 23, 1980 requested Pacific Gas and Electric Company to file a request with the California Public Utilities Commission for authorization, pursuant to Commission Decision No. 91239, to serve KMCC under Schedule G-55A, effective as early as permitted. KMCC also submitted a letter, dated January 23, 1980, to the Commission, directly requesting Commission action on this matter, absent a timely request by PG&E that could be treated at the Commission Conference of January 29, 1980.
2. KMCC requested service under Schedule G-55A for its cogeneration usages of natural gas in KMCC's Westend and Trona/Argus facilities, located in Searles Valley, California. Both the Westend and Trona/Argus facilities are qualifying cogeneration facilities under federal regulations promulgated by FERC for the Natural Gas Policy Act cogeneration exemption.
3. KMCC's exemption affidavits establishing such qualifying status have been filed with FERC and copies have been supplied to PG&E.
4. We find that the request should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation is authorized to receive service under PG&E Schedule G-55A from the effective date of that schedule.
2. This resolution is effective on the date adopted.
