SUBJECT: San Diego Gas & Electric Company. Order Authorizing Revisions to Tariff Rules Applicable to Gas, Electric and Steam Service Resulting in More Restrictive Conditions.

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (SDG&E), by Advice Letters Nos. 450-G, 504-E, and 112-H, all filed May 7, 1980, requests authority under Section 779 of the Public Utilities Code to amend its tariff rules applicable to Disputed Bills and Discontinuance of Service, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2914-G to 2918-G inclusive, 3596-E to 3600-E inclusive, and 410-H to 413-H inclusive, respectively, under the following conditions:

- 1. The primary purpose of these filings is to revise Rule 10, "Disputed Bills", in each of the utility's Gas, Electric, and Steam tariffs in order to conform with Section 779 of the Public Utilities Code, and to bring Rule No. 11, "Discontinuance and Restoration of Service" into conformance with other major California utilities.
- 2. One revision of Rule No. 10 would reduce the time that a customer has to make a required deposit with the Commission from 15 days to 7 days.
- 3. Rule No. 11 is also revised to include a paragraph stating that a customer's bill will be considered past due if not paid within 15 calendar days of presentation.
- 4. Even though both of the above provisions will bring the tariff rules into conformance with the Public Utilities Code and with the rules of other major California utilities, they do create more restrictive conditions than now exist and therefore require Commission approval.
- 5. The Commission staff has reviewed these matters and recommends that they be approved as presented, and

WHEREAS: We find that it is reasonable for SDG&E to revise the tariff rules for Gas, Electric, and Steam service as presented, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

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- 1. San Diego Gas & Electric Company be granted authority under Sections 454 and 779 of the Public Utilities Code to place each of the above sets of tariff sheets into effect in their respective tariff schedules effective June 6, 1980, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
- 2. Each of the above sets of tariff sheets be marked to show that they were made effective for filing by Resolution No. G-2355 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
