RETURN TO GAS BRANCH

SUBJECT: Southern California Gas Company. Order Authorizing Revision of the Excess Footage Costs For Gas Service Extensions.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SoCal), by Advice Letter No. 1216, filed May 30, 1980, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to Revise Rule No. 21, Gas Service Extensions, as set forth on Cal. P. U. C. Sheets Nos. 15675-G to 15697-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The revision to Rule No. 21 would increase the advance supplied by a customer from \$3.55 to \$4.10 for each foot of gas service extension beyond the allowable free length.
2. The reason for this revision is the utility's review of current construction costs in conformance with Section H.1. of Rule No. 21.
3. This filing will result in an estimated increase of \$247,000 for excess footage. No additional revenue will be realized by the utility because this money will offset increased construction costs, and


WHEREAS: We find that this revision is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,
