R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Southern California Gas Company to Provide Natural Gas Service to Industrial Boilers in Excess of 300 MCFd.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SoCal), by Advice Letter No. 1223, filed July 25, 1980, requests authority to supply natural gas service to various oil recovery operations, at an aggregate rate up to 60 million cubic feet per day, and

WHEREAS: Supplies of natural gas available to the utility are presently surplus to demand.

WHEREAS: The longer-term supply availability for this and other lower priority users is less certain, and

WHEREAS: A delay in granting the proposed service would result in increased costs to the southern California consumer, and

WHEREAS: We find that this request should be granted and that the gas use should be classified in Priority 4 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 86357; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Decision No. 89337 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the new industrial boiler fuel service up to an aggregate total of 60 MMcf for a six month period commencing July 31, 1980.
2. Southern California Gas Company shall apply for an extension if continuation of such service is desired beyond January 31, 1981.
3. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2366. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.


