RETURN TO GAS BRANCH

SUBJECT: Southwest Gas Corporation. Order Authorizing Revision of the Excess Footage Costs for Gas Service Extensions.

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION (SoWest), by Advice Letter No. 242, filed September 4, 1980, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to Revise Rules Nos. 15 and 16, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C Sheets Nos. 1954-G to 1957-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The revision of Rule No. 15, Gas Main Extensions, applicable to the utility's Placer County Rate Area, would increase the advance supplied by a customer from \$13.00 to \$14.85 for each foot of gas main extension beyond the allowable free length.

2. The revision of Rule No. 16, Gas Service Extensions, also applicable to the Placer County Rate Area, would increase the advance supplied by a customer from \$12.50 to \$14.50 for each foot of gas service extension beyond the allowable free length.

3. The reason for these revisions is the utility's review of current construction costs in conformance with Section E.2. of Rule No. 15 and Section H. of Rule No. 16 of the utility's filed tariffs.

4. This filing will result in an estimated increase of \$38,064 for excess footage. No additional revenue will be realized by the utility because this money will offset increased construction costs, and

WHEREAS: We find that these revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that:
