RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Southwest Gas Corporation. Order Authorizing Gas Service in Excess of 300 Mcfd for Industrial Use.

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION (SoWest) by a letter, dated October 13, 1980, has requested authority to provide temporary gas service to Southern California Edison Company (SCE), under the following conditions:

1. The purpose of the gas service would be to provide natural gas during the construction of SCE's Solar One project commencing in July, 1981 for a period of three months.

2. The terms of the service from SoWest to SCE will be according to the requirements of Southwest's Rule No. 13, Temporary Service.

3. Usage of this gas service will be classified as industrial with a peaking demand in excess of 300 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: We find that this request to provide gas service is reasonable and should be granted; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under the Provisions of Rule No. 19 of the utility's filed tariff schedule for Southwest Gas Corporation to provide the requested natural gas service to Southern California Edison Company effective November 14, 1980, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

2. The above letter shall be marked to show that it was approved for filing by Resolution No. G-2384 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
