SUBJECT: Pacific Gas & Electric Company. Order Authorizing Natural Gas Service in Excess of 300 Mcfd for Industrial Boiler Use.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 1117-G, filed November 3, 1980, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 89337, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 300 Mcf per day to United States Gasohol Corporation (Applicant) in Lockeford, San Joaquin County, under the following conditions:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional 1640 Mcfd, raising his existing consumption from 260 Mcfd to 1900 Mcfd.
2. Applicant will use this additional natural gas to fuel a new boiler in the production of ethanol alcohol, which in turn will be added to unleaded gasoline to produce gasohol.
3. Supplies of natural gas available to PG&E are adequate to fill this request for service.

WHEREAS: We find that this request should be granted and that the gas use should be classified in Priority 4 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 86357; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Decision No. 89337 and under Rule No. 19 of the utility's filed tariff schedules for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to provide the requested additional service to United States Gasohol Corporation.
2. The above advice letter shall be marked to show that it was accepted for filing by Resolution No. G-2387 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
