SUBJECT: San Diego Gas & Electric Company.	Order Authorizing

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (SDG&E), by letter dated November 17, 1980, has requested authority to place a Gas Refund Plan into effect under the following conditions:

Acceptance of Gas Refund Plan.

- 1. The proposed refund reflects funds received from SDG&E's supplier, Southern California Gas Company, (SoCal) in January, 1981, pursuant to Commission Resolution No. G-2360, dated July 2, 1980.
- 2. The refundable amount, including accrued interest to January, 1981, is approximately \$17,200,000, which averages, \$14.00 per residential customer and \$116.00 per small commercial customer.
- 3. The refund reflects overcollections for four separate periods of time ranging from January, 1973 to May, 1979.
- 4. Refunds to residential customers will be allocated to each customer reflecting the sales to that customer during the 12 month period ending November, 1980 or portion thereof and will be based upon the total refundable amount for the four refund periods.
- 5. Refunds to commercial customers will be allocated to each customer reflecting the actual sales to that customer in each of the refund periods and are based on the actual refundable amounts in each of the respective time periods with the total amount being the sum of the four refunds.
- 6. Refunds to eligible active customers will be reflected as a credit to their January 1981 bills, with refund checks being mailed to eligible former commercial customers.
- 7. Refunds are not contemplated for former residential customers, however, SDG&E will evaluate all requests from customers or former customers, through June 1981, who either did not receive a refund or who contend that the refund should be larger, and will make adjustments where deemed approriate.
- 8. The utility shall publish notices of the refund in all local news media throughout its service territory, requesting all who believe that they are entitled to a refund but did not receive one to contact the utility, and

WHEREAS: We find this refund plan to be acceptables; therefore, good cause appearing,

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority is granted under Section 453.5 of the Public Utilities Code for San Diego Gas & Electric Company to place the above refund plan into effect during the month of January, 1981.
- 2. San Diego Gas & Electric Company shall keep records of the refunds and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by August 1, 1981.
- 3. The above refund plan shall be marked to show that it was approved for filing by Resolution No. G-2390 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
