SUBJECT: Pacific Gas & Electric Company, Gas Department. Order
 Authorizing Revision in Lifeline Allowances for Disabled
 Persons.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 1121-G, filed November 24, 1980, requests authorization to revise the Lifeline Provisions of its residential tariff schedules applicable to its total rate area, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10668-G to 10672-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The lifeline provisions are revised to include multiple sclerosis (MS) patients with paraplegic/quadruplegic and other disabled persons receiving an additional winter lifeline allowance.
2. The additional allowance for MS patients is the same as for paraplegic/quadruplegic persons, namely 15, 25, 35 and 35 therms per month for full time residents in PG&E's climatic zones W, X, Y & Z, respectively.
3. This filing is a result of recent changes in Section 739 of the Public Utilities Code to include MS patients in the category of disabled persons requiring additional lifeline allowances, as prescribed by SB 1388, effective January 1, 1981.
4. Also included in this filing is a sample of a notice to be sent to all residential customers informing them of the availability of additional lifeline allowance for MS patients and how to apply if they qualify.
5. Some revenue reduction will be felt by PG&E by allowing additional lifeline allowances to another type of customer but it is impossible at this time to determine the extent of the revenue loss, and

WHEREAS: We find that this filing is reasonable and in keeping with the intent of SB 1388; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority is granted under Sections 701 and 739 of the Public Utilities Code for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to place the above tariff sheets into effect on January 1, 1981, which is the effective date of SB 1388.

2. The above advice letter and tariff sheets shall be marked to show that they were approved for filing by Resolution No. G-2394 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
