SUBJECT: Request for Natural Gas Allocations Deviating from the Procedures Established by Decision No. 85189, as Modified

WHEREAS: THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SoCal), by Advice Letter No. 1239, filed on December 4, 1980, has requested authority to temporarily allocate gas for the Los Angeles Department of Water Power (LADWP) Scattergood Generating Unit 3 (SGS-3) under the following conditions:

- 1. LADWP's requirements for SGS-3, which are presently P-5, would be served in parallel with P-3 until April 30, 1981.
- 2. Annual deliveries to LADWP would be limited to the quantities delivered to LADWP under presently effective curtailment procedures with the net effect being a change in the monthly deliveries.
- 3. SGS-3 is not equipped with standby fuel facilities.

WHEREAS: This request is the same as the one approved last year for SGS-3 in Resolution No. G-2311; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that: Southern California Gas Company is authorized to serve the requirements of LADWP's Scattergood Generating Station Unit 3 in parallel with P-3 service under the following conditions:

- 1. P-3 status shall terminate on April 30, 1981.
- 2. Total deliveries to LADWP shall be brought into parity with other P-5 customers by November 1, 1981.
- 3. If LADWP obtains gas deliveries from an independent source during this period, the special allocation arrangements, except P-5 parity obligations, would terminate.
- 4. If this Commission, by its decision pending in Case No. 9642, should authorize P-3 status to SGS-3, then this resolution shall be superseded and cancelled.
- 5. The above Advice Letter is to be marked to show that it was approved for filing by Resolution No. G-2399 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
