RETURN TO GAS BRANCH

SUBJECT: Pacific Gas & Electric Company, Gas Department. Order Authorizing Acceptance of Revisions to a Special Contract Previously Approved by Commission Action.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E), by Advice Letter No. 1124-G, filed December 2, 1980, has requested authority to file a supplemental agreement with Prudential Insurance Company of America, covering the installation of additional gas facilities within a commercial/industrial development in Milpitas, Santa Clara County, under the following conditions:

1. The original agreement was filed by Advice Letter No. 1073-G, and authorized by Commission Resolution No. G-2344 on April 2, 1980.

2. Both PG&E and Prudential now desire to amend and modify the existing agreement to provide an increase in charges due to additions in the original development.

3. The existing agreement has been amended as follows:

Total Cost of Facilities	\$ 90,065	\$ 92,288
Credit for Trenching & Backfilling	\$ 28,332	\$ 29,137
Advance to PG&E (Refundable)	\$ 61,733	\$ 63,151
Monthly Cost-of-Ownership Charge	\$900.65/mo.	\$922.88/mo.

4. The monthly Cost-of-Ownership charge remains as 1% of the total cost of the facilities and in all other respects than those outlined above the contract remains in full force and effect as originally approved.

5. In the event that refunds are made, the cost-of-ownership charge will be adjusted accordingly, and

WHEREAS: We find that these modifications to the existing contract are compensatory and non-discriminatory and will provide service to applicant in such a manner as not to place a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Authority is granted under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A and under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to place the revised contract into effect as of this date.
