RESOLUTION G-3129. SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY
ADVICE LETTER 756-G REQUESTING APPROVAL OF TARIFF RULES
THAT WOULD APPLY TO CUSTOMERS OF SCHEDULE GTCG.

ORDER CORRECTING ERROR

There are minor, inadvertent errors in the text of
Resolution G-3011 dated April 7, 1993.

Pursuant to Resolution A-4661 which authorizes the
Executive Director to sign orders involving the correction of
typographical clerical errors, and other obvious inadvertent
errors and omissions in the decisions and orders of the
Commission,

IT IS ORDERED that Resolution G-3011 is corrected as
follows:

1. Under Appendix A, Special Conditions 21, 23, and 24
should read "(Intentionally Blank)".
2. Under Appendix A, the second sentence in Special
Condition 22 should read: "In accordance with normal
procedures, customers may be subject to back-billing to
the last period in which they have demonstrated, or can
demonstrate, to the utility's satisfaction, eligibility
for this schedule."
3. Under Appendix A, the sentence under Special Condition
25 should read "Data gathered by the utility in
administering this schedule shall be treated as
confidential by the utility as required by D.91-05-007
or subsequent decisions."

This order is effective today.
