



KOP-South-6 was established at Legg Lake Park, on the western shore of the lake, looking southeast toward the Segment 7 transmission corridor. The expansive park view has level topography and a dramatic waterfront picnic area. Large water features are fairly rare in the Los Angeles Basin, so Legg Lake is a dramatic visual element in this landscape.

**Overall Visual Sensitivity: high.** For people visiting and recreating at Legg Lake in general and KOP-South-6 specifically, the ratings of high viewer exposure, high viewer concern, and moderate-to-high visual quality lead to a high overall visual sensitivity of the visual setting and viewing characteristics.
