



KOP-North-2 is located on Tehachapi Willow Springs Road at the point where the road turns northwest, after running north-south for many miles in the Mojave Desert. White wind turbine generators of the Tehachapi Wind Resource Area are visible on the right side of the view. The proposed Project would cross over the Tehachapi Willow Springs Road at approximately S10 MP-4.3 and would follow along the Los Angeles Aqueduct, an underground facility.

Overall Visual Sensitivity: low-to-moderate. For viewers on Tehachapi Willow Springs Road in general, and from KOP-North-2 specifically, the ratings of low visual quality, low viewer concern, and moderate-to-high viewer exposure lead to a low-to-moderate overall visual sensitivity of the visual setting and viewing characteristics.
