



KOP-North-4 was established at the Antelope Buttes Vista Point within the Antelope Valley California Poppy Reserve. The Poppy Reserve is a heavily-visited destination during poppy season. This specific location is a vista point identified on the Poppy Reserve trail map and is the viewpoint that is closest to the transmission corridor.

Overall Visual Sensitivity: high. For visitors to the California Poppy Reserve during poppy-blooming season in general, and from KOP-North-4 specifically, the high viewer exposure, high viewer concern, and high visual quality lead to a high overall visual sensitivity.
