



KOP-South-15 was established on Cork Drive, looking west. Cork Street is a north-south street that connects Tupelo Street on the south and Garden Court on the north, all of which is in a residential subdivision north of Chino Hills Parkway. TRTP Project Segment 8 would occupy the existing transmission corridor through this neighborhood.

Overall Visual Sensitivity: high. For residents of Cork Drive in general and KOP-South-15 specifically, the ratings of high viewer exposure, high viewer concern, and moderate-to-high visual quality lead to a high overall visual sensitivity of the visual setting and viewing characteristics.
