REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CONTENTS OF FIRST-AID KITS PROVIDED BY COMMON CARRIER RAILROADS IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Adopted November 9, 1965. Effective April 1, 1966 (Decision No. 69934, Case No. 8299)

As Amended by Decision No. 70072, dated December 7, 1965 and Order Extending Time, Dated December 31, 1965.

IT IS ORDERED by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California that each railroad corporation operating in the State of California shall provide and maintain in a plainly designated accessible location on all passenger trains, cabooses, and locomotives used in railroad operations, a first-aid kit in a sanitary container with the following minimum contents:

Table listing first-aid kit contents: 2 compressed roller bandages 2" x 6 yds., 1 bandage compress 4" x 4" with tails, 1 bandage compress 2" x 2", 16 long band adhesive bandages 1" x 3 3/8" (band aids), 1 gauze compress 24" x 72", 1 triangular bandage, 1 antiseptic soap, two ounce bottle with four 2" x 2" gauze pads, 6 kip burn ointment—or equivalent—1/8 oz. tubes, 1 first-aid pamphlet.

This order shall be effective April 1, 1966.
