

GENERAL ORDER No. 50-B
(Supersedes General Orders Nos. 50 and 50-A)

Railroad Commission of the State of California
IN THE MATTER OF SUBMITTING TO THE RAILROAD COMMISSION
PLANS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DAMS

Approved December 7, 1929. Effective January 7, 1930
(Decision No. 21886, Case No. 2774, 34 C.R.C. 70)

“It is hereby ordered, That all public utilities shall file with the Railroad Commission the final plans and specifications covering any construction, reconstruction, alteration or repair of dams within thirty (30) days after their approval by the State Engineer.”

This order shall become effective thirty (30) days from and after the date hereof, at which time General Orders No. 50 and 50-A shall be revoked and of no further force and effect.
