On March 13, 2008, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) voted unanimously to oppose your AB 1845, which would declare the Legislature's intent to transfer the responsibility for developing the priority list for the annual \$15,000,000 grade separation program from the Commission to the California Transportation Commission (CTC) upon completion of the expenditure of the \$150,000,000 in Proposition 1B general obligation bond funds that are to be allocated pursuant to the priority list process.
