**RE: AB 1920 (Huffman) – As amended June 12, 2008 – Oppose Unless Amended**  
**Status: Assembly Committee on Appropriations**

Dear Chair Kehoe:

On April 24, 2008, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) voted unanimously to oppose AB 1920 unless amended. Given the amendments of June 12, 2008, the Commission position to oppose unless amended still stands. This measure would expand net energy metering for solar customer-generators and require electric utilities to offer a standard contract for the purchase of net surplus electricity provided to the grid. The bill would require the Commission to determine the price paid for any net surplus electricity.
