Status: Senate Public Safety Committee Hearing – July 7, 2009

Dear Senator Leno:

On May 7, 2009, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) voted unanimously to support AB 951. This bill could improve public safety and consumer protection by increasing the levels of fines and penalties that may be levied by the Commission and the courts against charter-party carriers and others that violate the law. Some fines and penalties prescribed in the various sections of the Passenger Charter-Party Carriers' Act have not been increased in 20-25 years. Thus, increasing the levels of fines and penalties that may be imposed on violators will have a positive impact on public safety.
