AB 920 (Huffman) - As Introduced - Oppose Unless Amended

Status: Assembly Committee on Appropriations

Dear Assemblymember de Leon:

On May 7, 2009, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) voted unanimously to oppose AB 920 unless amended. AB 920 requires electric utilities to provide compensation for the value of net surplus electricity provided to the grid over a twelve-month period, or a credit in kilowatt-hours against future consumption.

This bill fundamentally changes the intent of the net energy metering (NEM) statute from a program that facilitates onsite electricity generation and consumption to a program that supports onsite customer generators to be paid as wholesale power producers. Customers currently receive significant ratepayer support to be onsite customer generators, and net surplus compensation would add another benefit to solar customers before the completion of the Commission's report on the costs and benefits of NEM, due to the legislature January 1, 2010.
