RE: SB 17 (Padilla) – As Introduced – Support with Amendments Status: Senate Energy, Utilities & Communications Committee

Dear Senator Padilla:

On April 16, 2009, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) voted unanimously to support SB 17 with amendments. SB 17 establishes as state policy the modernization of the state's electrical grid to maintain reliable and secure electrical service with infrastructure that can meet future growth in demand while achieving several other objectives such as integration of distributed generation resources, demand-side resources and 'smart' technologies.

The Commission opened a Rulemaking on December 18, 2008, in response to federal legislation, to consider policies for California investor-owned utilities (IOUs) to enhance the ability of the electric grid to support policy goals such as reducing green house gases, increasing energy efficiency and demand response, expanding use of renewable energy, and improving system reliability.
