	<b>SUMMARY:</b>	Relates to the Personal Income Tax and Corporation Tax laws. Disallows an income tax deduction for expenses of specified employers for parking

subsidies unless all employees provided with a parking subsidy are offered a parking cash-out program. Authorizes a tax credit for qualified commute reduction expenditures for specified small-business taxpayers.
