**TITLE:** Workforce Development: Renewable Energy  
**SUMMARY:**  
Requires the state Workforce Investment Board to establish a Renewable Energy Workforce Readiness Initiative to ensure green collar career placement and advancement opportunities within the renewable energy manufacturing, construction, installation, maintenance, and operation sectors and provide guidance to local workforce investment boards on assessment, training, and placement programs. Provides American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funding. Revises local board investment plan requirements.

CA AB 177 **AUTHOR:** Price (D)  
**TITLE:** Urban Communities Collaborative Initiative Act of 2009  
**SUMMARY:**  
Creates the Urban Communities Collaborative Initiative and an Inter-Agency Initiative Workgroup, partnership, and local committees for designated project areas and assign these entities duties for coordinating and improving government efforts for at-risk urban communities. Enacts the Urban Communities Collaborative Initiative Act of 2009. Authorizes the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency to develop regional plans and collaborative efforts in specified fields regarding economic development.

CA AB 310 **AUTHOR:** Price (D)  
**TITLE:** Employment: Green Workforce Partnership Program  
**SUMMARY:**  
Declares the Legislature's intent to establish a pilot program, known as the Green Workforce Partnership Demonstration Program, to develop workers for employment in green industries and environmentally sustainable business activities.

CA AB 380 **AUTHOR:** De La Torre (D)  
**TITLE:** Clean Energy Curriculum and Training Initiative  
**SUMMARY:**  
Creates the Clean Energy Curriculum and Training Initiative of 2009 to establish standardized curriculum for use at schools and provide outreach, assistance and guidance to schools on creating clean energy training programs. Creates a subaccount within the Labor and Workforce Development Fund. Requires that certain moneys collected by electrical corporations to fund research, development, and demonstration be transferred to the subaccount.

CA AB 1394 **AUTHOR:** Bass (D)  
**TITLE:** California Workforce Investment Board: Green Jobs  
**SUMMARY:**  
Authorizes the State Workforce Investment Council to accept any revenues, moneys, grants, goods, or services from federal and state entities and other sources, to be used for purposes relating to the administration and implementation of the strategic initiative to train and develop a skilled green economy workforce. Requires revenues to be deposited into the Green Collar Jobs Account. Requires the revenue to be expended for administration and implementation purposes of the initiative and grants.

CA SB 267 **AUTHOR:** Benoit (R)  
**TITLE:** Environmental Protection: Green Jobs  
**SUMMARY:**  
States the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would define "green jobs."

CA SB 675 **AUTHOR:** Steinberg (D)  
**TITLE:** Energy Job Training: Clean Technology  
**SUMMARY:**  
Enacts the Clean Technology and Renewable Energy Job Training, Career Technical Education, and Dropout Prevention Act of 2010. creates a related fund for grants to qualifying entities for the construction of facilities to enhance the educational opportunities for program participants to provide them with the skills and knowledge necessary for careers directly related to clean technology, renewable energy, or energy efficiency. Creates a related council to issue guidelines related to the act.
