TITLE: Emergency Telephone Users Surcharge
SUMMARY:
Relates to the Emergency Telephone Users Surcharge Act. Specifies that a minimum percentage of the charges for intrastate telephone communications services and VoIP service to which the surcharge applies be spent for those specialized purposes and costs including a percentage of the charges for intrastate telephone communications services and VoIP service to which the surcharge applies for a one-time payment to Primary Public Safety Answering Points for personnel costs.

TITLE: Broadband Communications
SUMMARY:
Requires the State Chief Information Officer to access and administer any moneys received by the state pursuant to the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Plan Act of 2009 that are directed for broadband-related activities, programs, or projects and develop a strategy to expedite accessing those funds, including the requirement to specify actions that should be taken to assess, fund, allocate, and install broadband in rural and underserved areas.

1184 **TITLE:** Automatic Dialing-Announcing Devices: Officials
SUMMARY:

Amends existing law that prohibits the use of automatic daily-announcing devices. Exempts from the prohibition the use of such devices by a state or local public official for a governmental purpose. Requires the Public Utilities Commission to determine what is not a governmental purpose for purposes of these provisions.

1497 **TITLE:** Public Utilities: Intervenor Fees
SUMMARY:

Relates to public utilities and intervenor fees funded through reimbursement fees collected from utilities. Requires an award related to a telephone corporation not regulated under a rate-of-return regulatory framework to be paid from the commission's intervenor compensation program fund. Relates to compensation for reasonable advocate's fees, expert witness fees and other reasonable costs to public utility customers of participation or intervention in any proceeding of the Public Utilities Commission.

1528 **TITLE:** Telecommunications: Lifeline Service Rates
SUMMARY:

Prohibits the Public Utilities Commission from authorizing a telephone corporation to increase rates or charges for local exchange services provided to lifeline telephone service subscribers above those in effect on a specified. Provides an increase shall be no greater than the cost-of-living percentage increase for the CalWORKs program. Prohibits the commission from authorizing carriers using alternative technologies to provide lifeline service only if the commission finds no reduction in service quality.

telecommunications customers' bills for funds to encourage the deployment of advanced communications services and establishes a program providing matching funds to build broadband infrastructure in unserved and underserved areas. Provides for the purpose of providing matching funds under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and the eligibility requirements for matching funds.
