CA AB 153 **AUTHOR:** Ma (D)
TITLE: High-Speed Rail Authority
SUMMARY:
Specifies that the High-Speed Rail Authority constitutes a governing body for the purpose of adopting a resolution of necessity. Excludes the authority with respect to property acquired for the construction of a high-speed rail system from the requirement that the property be acquired by the State Public Works Board.

CA AB 435 **AUTHOR:** De La Torre (D)
TITLE: Public Utilities: Transmission Facilities
SUMMARY:
Requires an electrical corporation or a local publicly owned electric utility that owns electrical transmission facilities to investigate and evaluate the cost and feasibility of using high-technology conductors and other advanced transmission technology in new and upgraded transmission projects. Requires such corporation to evaluate the cost and feasibility of retrofitting existing facilities with high-technology conductors and other advanced transmission technology.

CA AB 636 **AUTHOR:** Jones (D)
TITLE: Charter Party Carriers: Bus Drivers
SUMMARY:
Requires the Public Utilities Commission to permanently revoke the authority and to bar from receiving a permit or certificate a charter-party carrier operating a bus without the proper permit or a suspended permit, has improperly registered buses, or knowingly employs a driver who has not been issued the required endorsement or certificate. Prohibits a person from driving a bus a person without the proper endorsement or certification. Provides for inspections and impounds. Relates to new permits.

CA AB 709 **AUTHOR:** Lieu (D)
TITLE: Charter-Party Carriers of Passengers
SUMMARY:
Requires the Public Utilities Commission to adopt rules for criminal history background checks of drivers or applicants to be a driver for a charter party carrier of passengers that provides passenger transportation to and from any airport regularly serving an air carrier

holding a certificate issued by the United States Secretary of Transportation. Requires all drivers to carry identification credentials at all times on airport property.

TITLE: Transportation Capital Improvement Projects

SUMMARY:

States that local road rehabilitation projects are eligible for transportation capital improvement funds pursuant to the State Transportation Improvement Program.

TITLE: Regional Transportation Plans: Sustainable Communities

SUMMARY:

Provides that upon the state Air Resources Board's acceptance that the sustainable communities strategy or an alternative planning strategy, if implemented, will achieve the greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets established by the board, that acceptance shall be final, and no person or entity may initiate or maintain any judicial proceeding to review the propriety of the state board's acceptance. Revises the Regional Targets Advisory Committee membership. Relates to exempted transportation projects.

CA AB 951 **AUTHOR:** Lieu (D)
TITLE: Charter-Party Carriers

SUMMARY:

Amends the Passenger Charter Party Carriers Act. Revises the penalties for operating a charter party carrier of passengers or a taxicab without a valid certificate. Increase the mandatory fines for charter-party carriers of passengers for the first and subsequent convictions. Increases a number of other existing fees, fines, and penalties for specific violations of the act.

TITLE: Transportation Bond Funds: Transit System Safety

SUMMARY:

Relates to existing law which requires the deposit of a specified amount

of bond proceeds into the Transit System Safety, Security, and Disaster Response Account to be used, upon appropriation, for capital projects that provide increased protection against a security and safety threat. Requires the State Emergency Management Agency to provide a list, by a specified date, of projects and sponsoring agencies eligible to receive funds for regional public water transit systems.

TITLE: Strategic Area Freeway Enforcement Task Force

SUMMARY:

Establish the Strategic Area Freeway Enforcement Task Force to develop a work program that will optimize the effectiveness and efficiencies of the commercial vehicle enforcement network in southeast Los Angeles County focusing on addressing ongoing commercial vehicle enforcement issues and to recognize the benefits from specified technologies.

TITLE: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program

SUMMARY:

Relates to existing law authorizing the issuance of bonds for various transportation-related purposes, including reducing emissions and improving air quality in trade corridors, and which requires the State Air Resources Board to allocate the funds to be used for air quality purposes pursuant to specified requirements. Requires that priority be given to projects that secure other supplemental funding in an amount that is above a percentage requirement required by existing law.

TITLE: California Transportation Plan

SUMMARY:

Requires updating of the State Transportation Plan. Requires the plan to address how the state will achieve maximum feasible emissions reductions to order to attain a statewide reduction of greenhouse gas emission to certain levels by 2020 and 2050 and to identify the statewide integrated multimodal transportation system needed to achieve these results. Requires the Transportation Commission to submit a report providing information on sustainable communities and alternative planning strategies.

TITLE: Department of Railroads
SUMMARY:
Creates the Department of Railroad and transfers to the department responsibility for various state railroad programs currently administered by other agencies. Provides that the department shall be the only state agency eligible to apply for and receive grant and loan funds from the federal government for intercity rail, high-speed rail, or freight rail purposes. Convenes a joint task force to resolve jurisdiction overlap issues. Includes the Director of Railroads in the High-Speed Rail Authority.

SUMMARY:
Prohibits a person from operating a bicycle on a highway if that person is riding other than upon or astride a permanent and regular seat attached to the bicycle, unless the bicycle was designed by the manufacturer to be ridden without a seat.

TITLE: Ports: Congestion Relief: Air Pollution Mitigation
SUMMARY:
Requires the Ports of Long Beach, Los Angeles, and Oakland to assess their infrastructure and air quality improvement needs including projects that improve the efficiency of the movement of cargo, reduce congestion impacts associated with the movement of cargo, and reduce pollution associated with the movement of cargo. Requires each port to provide the assessment to the Legislature and to include an assessment of the cost of such improvements, possible funding options, and timelines for implementation.
